Looking to a weekend ahead, there are still VBS bookings available on Saturday from 1300 onwards and on Sunday from 1400 onward. At this stage look like majority of VBS booking for Monday has been picked up already. Please continue to monitor the pool for relisted slots.

Between Friday and Monday, we expect to receive approx. 4,000 import containers into our yard. Road operators, please ensure to target maximum import uplift to help keep yard utilisation at a workable level. We appreciate that there are other demands on capacity across the supply chain

## Multi-Cargo Operations

**Berth and Yard Capacity** – Freyberg berths are at 100% utilised and will be for the foreseeable future, Jellicoe berths are also at 100%. Container volumes are high with yard utilisation currently also at 95%. Bledisloe, Capt. Cook and the Car Handling Facility are currently at 90% utilisation with 7 PCCs inbound over the coming week.

We wish to remind exporters and transport companies that shipping schedules for vessels calling Multi Cargo wharves are fluid and can change without advance notice. We urge you to liaise directly with the shipping lines for most up to date information on vessel receival & cut off times, arrivals and departures.

**Road Services** - Container and Breakbulk R&D will continue to be busy for both receivals and deliveries. Bulk R&D ongoing on Freyberg Wharf. Vehicle deliveries are currently low but will increase significantly throughout the week and weekend.

**Other** - Regular testing does not replace the need for COVID-19 controls and related PPE. Continue to practice good hygiene and follow port safety and COVID-19 controls.
