

# **Operational Update**

# 18<sup>th</sup> May 2022

## **Overall Operational status**

**Key points:** Container Terminal Yard utilisation is at 79% today.

Terminal operations are running well. No change to the macro environment: Offshore conditions are causing vessel delays and cargo flows will remain 'lumpy'.

**Link/On-dock Empty Container Depot** – Link facility is at 80% utilisation.

Road Services - Turn times are 21 minutes. In the last 48 hours 1,270 import containers left the terminal via road and 185 left via rail.

For those companies running empties into Link please ask your drivers to use both entry lanes to avoid queues forming out onto Tamaki Drive.

Rail Services – Rail operations are running as expected.

# Multi-cargo (MC) Operations

Container/Bulk berths are currently at 70% but increasing to 100% this week.

PCC - currently at 100% which continues throughout this week and into next week with 6 x scheduled vessels.
